
Motorcycle Wireless CarPlay / Android Auto w. Bike Holder - 5" User Manual



Introduction





- 1. Main Menu: Access the primary options.
- 2. Current Status Display: View the current system status.
- 3. Date & Time: Shows the year, month, day, week, and current time.
- 4. Current Volume: Displays and adjusts the volume level.
- 5. Time Display: Indicates the current time.
- 6. Media Playback Status: Shows playback progress.
- 7. Day/Night Mode: Toggle between day and night settings.
- 8. Return to Menu: Go back to the main navigation screen.



Main interface

- 1. This device supports multiple screens. Use the application icon on the main interface to enter and swipe right to switch screens.
- 2. Tap the home button to access the main interface and use the back button for the higher-level menu.
- 3. Use the time icon to access the time setting page.
- 4. Tap the sound icon to adjust volume settings.

5. Select the day/night mode icon to toggle between night mode and screen-off mode.

Android Auto

Open the Application Interface:

- Tap the app icon on the main screen to enter the interface. Follow the prompts to connect your device based on your preferences.





- Ensure your Android phone supports Google services.
- Install essential apps from the Google Play Store (Google Maps, Assistant, Play Store).
- Ensure Bluetooth is turned on and your device is connected.

Setting Up Android Auto:

- 1. Open the Android Auto app on your phone.
- 2. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete installation and updates.
- 3. If it runs without issues, the setup is successful.

Pairing Devices:


- 1. Access Settings: The settings panel will pop up automatically on your phone.
- 2. Open Google Maps: Tap the Maps icon for navigation assistance.
- 3. Make Calls: Use the phone icon to make calls directly.
- 4. Exit: Tap to return to the car's main interface.

Important Tips:

- You can connect using various methods, including Bluetooth. Make sure the connection is stable.
- Follow any prompts during setup to install or update necessary apps.
- Switch seamlessly between navigation, calls, and other functions while driving.

CarPlay

- 1. Tap the CarPlay icon to enter the application interface.
- 2. Follow the prompts to connect your iPhone.





Steps for Wireless Connection:

- CarPlay connects wirelessly via Bluetooth, no need for a hotspot.
- 1. Turn on Bluetooth on your iPhone and pair with the car's system.
- 2. Enter the provided PIN if prompted.
- 3. Confirm the connection on your iPhone.

Once connected, the CarPlay interface appears on the screen, allowing you to use features like music, maps, and calls directly.

TF Card Media Playback

Using the TF Card Interface:

- 1. Tap the TF icon to open the media playback interface.
- 2. Browse and select audio or video files to play directly from the TF card.

Supported Formats:

- Audio/Video: AVI, MKV, MP4, MPG, MP3, WAV, FLAC, AAC, and more.
- Images: BMP, GIF, JPG, PNG

Playback Controls:

- Music: Play, pause, next/previous track
- Video: Standard controls for play and navigation
- Picture: View images directly from the card

Bluetooth (BT) Setup and Usage

Connecting via Bluetooth:

- 1. Tap the icon to access the BT interface.
- 2. Ensure your phone's Bluetooth is on, search for "CAR-BT-1AE," and connect.
- 3. Enter the PIN code when prompted to complete pairing.

Making and Receiving Calls:

- 1. Use the keypad to input a phone number. Delete if needed by pressing the 'X.'
- 2. Press the call button to dial.
- 3. End the call using the end button.

Additional Functions:


- Once connected, enjoy hands-free calls and music playback directly through the car's system.






Phone book:

- 1. Tap Sync Contact to synchronise your phone's contact list.
- 2. Use the search function to find contacts easily.




Bluetooth Call Records:

- 1. Sync current, missed, and dialled call logs.
- 2. Tap on a call record to directly dial the number.



Bluetooth Music Playback:

- 1. Connect to your phone for music control: play, pause, skip tracks.
- 2. Access music players on your phone and start playback using the car interface.
- 3. Control playback using previous/next and play/pause buttons.




Connecting Bluetooth Earphones:

- 1. Open the Bluetooth earphone interface by tapping the BT Ear icon.
- 2. Enable pairing mode on your earphones and search for available devices.
- 3. Select your earphones from the list to connect. The device name will appear, confirming a successful connection.



Operating Paired Earphones:

- Once connected, you can transmit audio from both Bluetooth music and TF card playback.
- 2. Use the interface controls to search, connect, or disconnect devices, ensuring smooth operation for calls and music playback.



DVR Function Guide

Accessing the DVR Interface:

- Tap the DVR icon to open the recorder interface, allowing access to various recording functions.

Interface Functions Overview:

- 1. Photograph: Take snapshots.
- 2. Transcribe: Record audio notes.
- 3. Lock: Protect recordings from being overwritten.
- 4. Recording: Start/stop video recording.
- 5. Switch View: Toggle between front and rear cameras.
- 6. Video Recording: Manages video capture.
- 7. Cycle Time Setting: Adjust recording duration.
- 8. DVR Settings: Configure general recorder settings.

Settings Operation:

Access via the settings icon:

- 1. Recording On/Off
- 2. Cycle Time: Set intervals (1/2/3/5 mins)
- 3. Memory Card: Format option
- 4. Version Information

Settings Configuration

Accessing the Settings Menu:

- Tap the settings icon to open the main configuration page.

Basic Settings

- 1. Driving Prohibition Video: Enable or disable video functions while driving.
- 2. Touch Calibration: Adjust and recalibrate the touchscreen.
- 3. Restore Factory Settings: Reset the device to its original state.




Factory Settings

1. Accessing Factory Settings: Enter the required password to proceed with advanced configurations, including system resets and detailed adjustments.



Equaliser (EQ)

- 1. Access the EQ settings via the icon on the TF card or Bluetooth music interface, or through the settings menu.
- 2. Choose from 6 preset sound effects or customise using 10 adjustable EQ bands.




Display Settings

- 1. Adjust Brightness, Contrast, Color, and Saturation (default set to 50).
- 2. Use Reset to restore default values.



Screen Saver

- 1. Toggle the screen saver On/Off.
- 2. Set a timer (10 sec to 30 min).
- 3. Preview the screen saver effect before activating.



Desktop Background

Changing Background:

- Tap on any image to switch the desktop wallpaper.



Language Settings

- Supports multiple languages including English, Chinese, French, and more. Click to select and switch.



Time Settings

- 1. Use the time icon to enter the setup interface.
- 2. Manually set time zones and formats (12-hour/24-hour), or connect to Bluetooth for automatic calibration.

Version Display Details:

- 1. OS Operating System information
- 2. APP Application details
- 3. MCU Microcontroller unit details
- 4. BT MAC Bluetooth MAC address
- 5. BT SET Bluetooth settings information




Dropdown Bar

Accessing Dropdown Menu:

Swipe down from the top of the screen to reveal quick settings.

Dropdown Menu Functions:

- 1. TFT Toggle screen on/off
- 2. Bluetooth Access Bluetooth settings
- 3. Mute Volume toggle
- 4. Sound Effects Open sound settings
- 5. Brightness Adjustment Screen brightness control
- 6. Music Previous/Next track
- 7. Sound Adjust volume level



Power-On Startup Password

Default Password:

- The initial startup password is set to 0000.

Changing the Password:

- You can customise the power-on password by navigating to the Settings menu and updating it as needed. This ensures secure access and easy personalization of your device.
